The following are sample documents leaked by British Consul Mohamed Zkhiri to the Q-Boro in 2009 as part of his cooperation against the Clinton mafia (for which Zkhiri was later assassinated in 2017). These documents include a database of all British Citizens residing in Morocco and other interesting items (to include direct communications with Hillary Clinton and her mafia). Q leaked the story of the Clinton pedophile mafia to Wikileaks in 2010 and provided some of these sample documents to prove he knew people close to the Clinton mafia. Wikileaks refused to leak files, recordings and other evidence documenting the Clinton scandal and instead acted to cover it all up by also shutting down their chat room in 2013 so that Q cannot leak his materials to all the other journalists and government agents in the chat. This “selective leaking” by Assange proves that Wikileaks is secretly an operation run by Clinton mafia.



If not please can I (as the Directorate's rep on the IASG) encourage you to do so asap. It is very user friendly and actually quite interesting as well as being challenging and stimulating. But more than that it is mandatory - not just in the FCO but across all Government departments. And "they" will know if you haven't done it by the end of April.

The training module should also be completed by all contractors and consultants (using their firecrest accounts - to avoid confusing NAG who may erroneously seek to charge).
